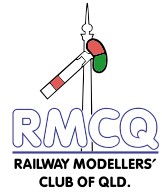

CLUB USE ONLY			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fees are payable yearly in advance, pro-rata to the next 30 June. eg, if you join the club in October, you only pay 8/12 of the annual fee plus, if applicable, a joining fee. • The joining fee includes one club shirt with logo, one name badge, club website private members access, clubroom usage and voting privileges. • Ordinary, Senior and Country members have full privileges. • Associate members may use the clubroom, but not the model railway layouts or workshops. They may not vote or have keys to the clubhouse. • Ordinary, Senior and Country members may apply for a clubhouse key & access code after 6 months membership. • The spouse, children/grandchildren/great grandchildren (U/18) of Ordinary, Senior and Country members have the same privileges as the main member, but do not receive a free shirt and name badge, may not vote or have a club key. As children turn 18, they are to apply for their own membership. • Previous Ordinary, Senior and Country members who rejoin do not pay a second joining fee. • Associate members who upgrade to a higher category pay an increased membership fee plus a joining fee.

OUR LAYOUTS

We have large G, HO/00, HO_n3.5 and N scale [layouts](#). Members run freight and passenger trains from various countries including Australia, US, UK, Europe and Japan.



'Grendale' G gauge layout. Our [elevated garden layout](#) has an 80 m dual mainline with four double-ended sidings. Members run electrical-powered and live steam trains.

HO/00/HO_n3.5 layout. This has an 85 m double mainline on the [bottom deck](#) with a helix up to a similar-sized top deck. It includes a staging yard for each gauge with numerous sidings, industries and passenger stations.

'South Pine' HO/00/HO_n3.5 scale exhibition layout. This 8.6x2 m portable layout includes HO and narrow gauge mainlines.

'Buckley Park' N scale layout. This layout has a [bottom deck](#) with a 28 m, 4-track mainline and a [top deck \(link2\)](#) with a 75 m mainline and [wharf area](#). There is provision for a third deck in the future.

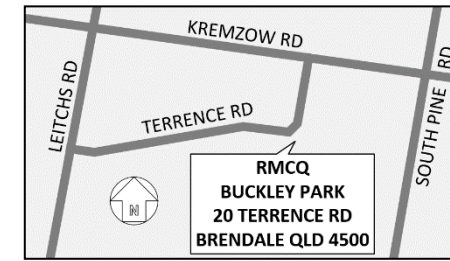


'Pine Rivers' N scale exhibition layout. This 8x2 m layout is a popular exhibit on the train show circuit. Its 3-track mainline winds through open and [hilly country](#). With a shunting area and passenger shuttle, the layout can run eight trains simultaneously to keep the crowds entertained.

OUR CLUBHOUSE



Our club is situated in Brendale, about 17 km north of Brisbane city. We have a dedicated 480 m² clubhouse, plus a separate 4-bay garage for our
